The senior outside hitter was the area's Divisions II-III player of the year. She was the Miami Valley Conference Scarlet division player of the year. She had 210 kills.

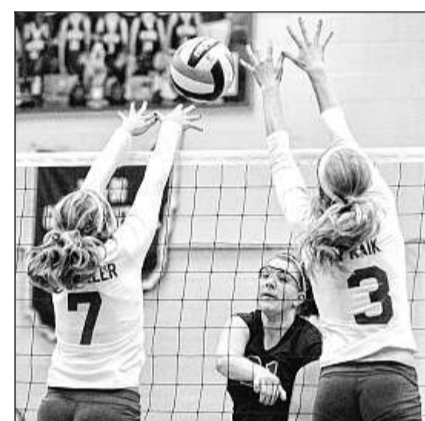
DIV. III-IV COACH OF THE YEAR
